WE, representing the Diponegoro University, and the University of Wisconsin, wishing to enhance our students master's level educational experiences in law, agree to a dual degree program under the terms described below.

ARTICLE 1

Under this mutual agreement, student already enrolled in the master of laws (MIH [Magister Ilmu Hukum]) program at Diponegoro University will be able to earn up to six credits towards the Diponegoro University [M I H] degree from coursework taken at the university of Wisconsin while they are an accepted and enrolled student in the master in legal Institutions (M.L.I) program at the University of Wisconsin.

ARTICLE 2

Under this mutual agreement, student already enrolled in the master of laws (M.I.H) program at Diponegoro University will be able to earn up to six credits toward the University of Wisconsin Master of Legal Institution degree from coursework taken at Diponegoro University while they are an accepted and enrolled M.I.H student at that institution.

ARTICLE 3

Such reciprocal credits, specified in Article 1 and Article 2, shall be granted only to a student who is already actively pursuing the M.I.H. degree at Diponegoro University. Thus, a student wishing to take advantage of the terms of this agreement must already be admitted to and enrolled in the M.I.H. program at Diponegoro University and be a student in good standing.

ARTICLE 4

Credit for coursework taken at the partner institution shall be granted only upon the approval of the home institution. Each institution retains the right to grant reciprocal credits only after a review of the courses taken. Each institution retains discretion to grant or not to grant reciprocal credits.

ARTICLE 5

Each institution shall retain complete control over its graduate admissions policies.

ARTICLE 6

This agreement pertains to and is limited to the reciprocal application towards graduation credit at the home institution of up to six (6) credits taken at the partner institution. This agreement does not pertain to other points, such as living expenses, tuition, or other such matters.

ARTICLE 7

This agreement is open to revision and amendment by mutual consent of the representatives of

the respective law faculties. It is understood that this agreement is a new endeavor between the two institutions. After the first year of implementation, the representatives agree to communicate with each other to review the efficacy of the dual degree program procedure and make suggestions for change, as needed.

ARTICLE 8

This agreement shall be in effect until canceled by either party and may be canceled by either party. In case of cancellation, sufficient notice shall be given so as not to adversely affect the ability of students enrolled at the time of cancellation from earning their degrees pursuant to this agreement.

The parties hereto cause this Agreement to be executed by their signatures on this 16 day of May 2008.





APPENDIX

Diponegoro University and the University of Wisconsin Law School have concluded an Agreement dated 16 September, 2008 for the purpose of promoting friendly relations and academic exchange between the two institutions. The purpose of this Appendix is to describe the student exchange to be established under the Agreement.


AGREED:

1. Each institution will make an effort to promote and develop cooperation in the exchange of students in master's programs in law based upon the principles of equality and reciprocity:
2. The two institutions agree to exchange at most five students from each institution starting with the month of January in the year 2009 and shall continue for three years.
3. Participating students from Diponegoro University and University of Wisconsin may participate in course work offered by both institutions under supervision by appointed supervisors
4. A certificate showing the completion of the master's degree program will be presented to the participating students when all program requirements have been met.
5. The host institute will provide the necessary academic facilities to the participating students.
6. Diponegoro University and the University of Wisconsin Law School agree to try to develop a staff exchange program that includes collaborative research, conferences, and publications, as an adjunct to this student exchange effort.

7. Diponegoro University and University of Wisconsin agree to explore the possibility of a reciprocal exchange of credit program at the master's level in their respective law schools.
8. Diponegoro University and University of Wisconsin Law School shall bear its own costs and expenses involved in carrying out this exchange agreement.
9. Any dispute arising out of this agreement should be resolved in a spirit of cooperation between Diponegoro University and the University of Wisconsin
10. This Appendix shall begin on the first day of November in the year 2008 and shall continue thereafter for three (3) years, subject from time to time to revisions or modifications by mutual agreement. After the initial three (3) years, this Agreement shall be renewed with the same terms, unless either institution withdraws from the Agreement with six (6) months prior written notice.
11. Either institution may terminate this Agreement effective at the end of any calendar year period by giving written notice to the other institutions no less than six (6) months prior to the end of any such year period.
